

Whether you are a long-standing resident or new to Shediac, we would like to take this opportunity to inform you about regulations pertaining to various Town by-laws. Our goal is to help promote safety and raise awareness among the residents of Shediac to make our town an even more enjoyable place to live.

Did you know?

About pets

- You cannot keep or possess more than two dogs and/or two cats in a household without obtaining a valid permit.
- > Animals in a public place need to be kept on a leash.
- A valid license is required each year for your dogs.
- > A barking dog is considered a disturbance.
- > Pet owners are required to pick up after their pet.
- > Pets need to be vaccinated against rabies.

About collection and disposal of waste

- Waste must be placed into clear garbage bags.
- Recyclable items must be placed into a clear blue bag.
- Organics must be placed into a clear green bag or a specific container for organic items.
- > We offer a branch collection program.
- Large or bulky items are collected on specific dates throughout the year.
- Provided they do not obstruct traffic, large or bulky items can be placed on the side of the street 7 days before the pickup day.

About nuisances

- Grass and weeds cannot exceed 0.2 metre in height.
- > RVs need to be parked in the backyard.
- > Inoperable vehicles, building materials, metals, appliances, furniture and other chattels or trash cannot be kept on property.
- > Snow or ice from private property cannot be pushed onto sidewalks on public streets.

About noise

- Quiet hours are from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- > The noise by-law applies to any excessive noise at any time.

About fire pits

- > A valid permit is required to use a fire pit.
- > Even with a permit, be aware of the restrictions in place before using your fire pit.
- > Fires need to be extinguished by 11 p.m.

About vendors

- > Street vendors are no longer permitted to operate.
- Residents need to obtain a permit from the Town to hold a yard sale.

About parking

- From November to April, parking on public streets is prohibited from midnight to 7 a.m. to allow for snow removal.
- > Vehicles are prohibited from parking in the bike lane.
- > Vehicles are permitted to park for 90 minutes maximum in designated parking areas.
- > See By-law 15-28 for parking restrictions on specific streets.

About watering

> During the months of June, July and August, watering is allowed only from 5 a.m. to 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. Restrictions may apply depending on specific situations.

About school zones

> The speed limit is 30 km/h from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on school days.
