



NOTICE TO ALL DOG OWNERS MUNICIPAL BY-LAW RESPECTING ANIMAL CONTROL

The Animal Control By-law for the Town of Shediac stipulates that:

- Every owner of a dog shall register such dog on or before the 31st day of January of each year.
- Licence and dog tags may be purchased from the Animal Control Officer or at the Shediac Veterinary Hospital at a cost of \$10.00 for a dog that has been spayed or neutered; \$20.00 for a fertile dog of either sex or \$200.00 for a dangerous dog.
- Any owner of a dog not obtaining a registration tag for such dog by the required dates shall pay a penalty of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars, to be added to the regular registration fee.
- The owner of a dog shall prove to the satisfaction of the Animal Control Officer that he is in possession of a valid rabies vaccination certificate for such dog, signed by a registered veterinarian every year.
- No owner of an animal shall allow such animal to run at large in the municipality.
- No owner of an animal shall suffer or permit the animal to cause a public nuisance or disturb inhabitants by barking, howling or otherwise making noise; annoy pedestrians or drivers of automobiles, bicycles or other vehicles by running or barking at the same; to bite or attempt to bite a person; in an aggressive or terrorizing manner, approach any person in an apparent attitude of attack upon any street, sidewalk, public grounds or places, or on private property other than the property of the owner.
- No owner of an animal shall suffer or permit the animal to defecate on any private or public property in the Town of Shediac that is not the property of its owner.
- The owner of an animal shall remove forthwith any faeces left by the animal on a property other than the property of the owner.
- No owner of an animal shall suffer or permit the animal to cause damage to property that is not the property of the owner.
- No owner of a female dog shall suffer or permit such dog to be upon the street or in any public place while the dog is in heat.
- Any person, corporation, firm, partnership, society or association who violates any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for a first offence and to a fine of seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) for subsequent offences up to a maximum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00).
