#### **Molly's Game** (2017) Bio/Crime/Drama

The true story of Molly Bloom, an Olympic-class skier who ran the world's most exclusive high-stakes poker game and became an FBI target.

Fredo is a fisherman whose wife and child perished in a boating accident, and he approaches the sea with the angry determination of a man out for revenge. Fredo commands a crew of young people from poor families as he takes his ship out in search of fish that live along the reefs, snaring catch with an illegal netting system.

The film won 13 out of 14 nominations in the 1999 Metro Manila Film Festival, including Best Picture.

Set in New York City during the early 1950s, *Carol* tells the story of a forbidden affair between an aspiring female photographer and an older woman going through a difficult divorce.

The British Film Institute named *Carol* the best LGBT film of all time.

#### **José Rizal** (1998) Philippine historical drama

175 minutes. Filipino (English sub-titles)

Director: Marilou Diaz-Abaya

Cast: Cesar Montano, Chin Chin Gutierrez

Based on the true story of Filipino patriot José Rizal, who was imprisoned under Spanish colonization.

The film was an entry to the 1998 Metro Manila Film Festival, and swept most of the nominations with seventeen awards, making it the film with the most MMFF award wins.

#### **Philadelphia** (1993) Drama

126 minutes English (French subtitles)

Director: Jonathan Demme

Cast: Tom Hanks, Denzil Washington, Jason Robards, Mary Steenburgen, Antonio Banderas, Joanne Woodward.

One of the first mainstream Hollywood films to address HIV/AIDS and homophobia, this movie was a multi-award-winner, including the Oscar for best actor for Tom Hanks. Inspired by a true story.
